GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The title for this competition is “Win some spring days out to Hampshire”
2. The competition is open to UK residents only (excluding residents of the Channel Islands and Isle of Man). Employees of Hampshire County Council, the National Trust, The Watercress Line and Hurst Marine as well as their immediate families are not eligible to enter the competition. Entrants must be over the age of 18 to enter.
3. Entrants must provide their name and email address if selected at random as the winner. They must agree to the general terms and conditions and privacy policy.
4. Visit Hampshire will only ever use personal details for the purposes of administering the competition. Visit Hampshire will only keep your personal details for as long as is necessary to fulfil these purposes. Visit Hampshire will not pass on your personal information to a third party without your prior permission. Visit Hampshire abide by the General Data Protection Regulation of 2018 and complies with its provisions to ensure that any data you provide is treated accordingly.

The competition closes at 23:59 on 2 March 2025. Entries received after this date will not be considered. There are three prizes in total. One prize will be allocated to one separate winner. The prize consists of;

- A one-day family pass for 1ad and 2ch to Mottisfont House & Gardens
- A family ticket, including ferry tickets to Hurst Castle
- A family ticket to the Watercress Line

The prize stated cannot be deferred or transferred. There will be no cash alternatives.

5. One competition entry per person.
6. The judges' decisions will be final and no correspondence can be entered into.
7. Visit Hampshire reserves the right to cancel this competition or alter any of the rules at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
8. There is no cash alternative for the prize and it is non-transferable.

9. The winner will be selected at random on Monday 3 March 2025. If the winners are unable to be contacted after reasonable attempts have been made, Visit Hampshire reserves the right to either offer the prize to a runner up, or to re-offer the prize in any future competition.

10. These rules are governed by the laws of England and Wales. This competition is administered by Visit Hampshire (Hampshire County Council)

10. By entering, entrants will be deemed to have agreed to be bound by these rules and Visit Hampshire reserves the right to exclude any entry from the competition at any time and in its absolute discretion if Visit Hampshire has reason to believe that an entrant has breached these rules.

11. The winners' details will be shared with the National Trust, The Watercress Line and Hurst Marine. By entering the competition, the participants agree that their name may be released on social media. Your email address will NOT be shared with any other party. Entry to the competition is free. An eligible entrant must be an individual and agree to abide by these terms and conditions.

11. The Mottisfont tickets consists of a family day pass valid during normal opening times.

- The ticket must be surrendered upon admission and is not transferrable against cost of membership.
- Photocopies will not be accepted.
- No cash alternative.
- The ticket cannot be used in conjunction with any other offer.
- Not valid for National Trust events or where a separate ticket fee applies.
- The ticket can be used for 2ad and 2ch or 1ad and 3ch.
- Ticket valid until 31 December 2025.

12. The Watercress Lines ticket is valid for 2ad and 3ch for standard travel.

- Excludes special events days such as Days out with Thomas.
- Ticket valid until 31 October 2025.

13. Hurst Castle tickets are for a family day entry ticket to Hurst Castle plus return ferry journey for 2ad and 3ch (age 5-17).

- Valid until 31 October 2025 during standard opening times.
- Return ferry ticket is from Keyhaven to Hurst Castle.
